Request for Executive Summary/ Proposals

Program Summary:

The Supportive Housing Program (SHP) and Homeless Crisis Response Program (HCRP) – Shelter are Ohio Development Services Agency (ODSA) funded grant programs for which agencies apply directly to ODSA biannually. SHP can fund Permanent Supportive Housing projects and limited Transitional Housing projects for select sub-populations. HCRP – Shelter can only fund emergency shelters.

Funding Priorities for PY2018:

Funding priorities for SHP and HCRP are determined by the Homeless Continuum of Care of Stark County (HCCSC) based on local gaps/needs and driven by ODSA policy priorities (Permanent Supportive Housing projects will be prioritized for the PY2018/2019 SHP application).

Local Review Process:

All projects submitting an application to ODSA must have the local CoC (Homeless Continuum of Care of Stark County)'s approval. A portion of the ODSA application must be completed by the HCCSC describing how projects were reviewed and approved by the HCCSC and must include signed approval from the HCCSC.

Agencies who plan to submit an application to ODSA must follow the local process as outlined below:

Agencies who plan to submit an application to ODSA for SHP or HCRP (Shelter) funding, which will be due to ODSA via the electronic OCEAN's application system on June 25th 2018, must submit an Executive Summary/Proposal, by **June 1st 2018** to mbragg@starkhousingnetwork.org. Executive Summary/Proposal must include the following details:

- Contact person for the Project
- Project Name
- Project Type
- Target population and number to be served
- Project Description (including scope of services that will be provided by recipient and any service agency partners, explanation of any changes that will be requested if a renewal and a description of how the project is implementing Housing First principles.)
- Budget Summary (including match sources which must equal 1:2 ratio)

HCCSC's Recipient Approval and Evaluation Committee will review all SHP/HCRP shelter proposals and make recommendations to the HCCSC Board of Directors regarding which projects should be recommended for SHP/HCRP Shelter funding. The HCCSC Board of Directors will review the Committee's recommendations and either approve or amend them to formulate its final recommendations. The Board's final recommendations are then forwarded to the Stark County Commissioners who will assist in completing CoC approval portions of the recommended SHP/HCRP Shelter projects for the ODSA applications.
