

Funds Available for Housing Projects Serving the Homeless

The Homeless Continuum of Care of Stark County (HCCSC) is currently preparing an application for funding of local housing projects serving the homeless. It will submit that application to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) by September 30, 2019 in response to a Notice of Funding Availability (NOFA) that HUD issued on July 3, 2019 for its Continuum of Care Grant Program.

The local competition to determine which projects will receive the HCCSC's endorsement to apply for HUD funding began on April 12, 2019 with a published notice of the application workshop occurring on April 30, 2019. All projects seeking to apply needed to submit completed applications to the HCCSC by May 31, 2019. After reviewing the NOFA, the HCCSC has concluded that there are additional funds for Domestic Violence (DV) Bonus projects in the amount of \$258,553. When applying for the DV Bonus funds, an agency may apply for the following project types; Rapid Re-Housing and Supportive Service Projects providing coordinated entry. For additional criteria, refer to the Notice of Funding Availability (NOFA) for the Fiscal Year (FY) 2019 Continuum of Care Program Competition (FR-6300-N-25).

Organizations that wish to apply for available funds must submit their applications by Friday August 23, 2019 at 12:00 noon, to Marcie Bragg at The Ken Weber Community Campus at Goodwill, 408 9th St. SW Canton, OH 44707 or by email to mbragg@starkhousingnetwork.org. Applicants will also have to be in a position to submit their completed HUD application by Friday, August 23, 2019. The HCCSC will make the full CoC Consolidated Application available to the public by September 26, 2019 through publication on its website.
