

Funds Available for Housing Projects Serving the Homeless

The Homeless Continuum of Care of Stark County (HCCSC) is currently preparing an application for funding of local housing projects serving the homeless. It will submit that application to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) by November 16, 2021 in response to a Notice of Funding Opportunity (NOFO) that HUD issued on August 18, 2021 for the FY2021 Continuum of Care Program Competition.

The local competition determines which projects will be prioritized by the HCCSC to apply for HUD funding. All projects seeking to apply need to submit a completed eSNAPS application and FY2021 HCCSC Scoring Criteria and Score Sheet Appendix by October 6th, 2021. CoC reallocation and Bonus funding will be available for new or expansion project applications. Domestic Violence (DV) Bonus funding is available in the amount of \$470,576 and CoC Bonus funding is available in the amount of \$156,859.

Eligible new projects for DV Bonus funds include PH-RRH and SSO-CE. Eligible new projects for CoC Bonus funding include PH-PSH, PH-RRH, HMIS, and SSO-CE.

Organizations that wish to apply for available funds must submit their eSNAPS applications and FY2021 HCCSC Scoring Criteria and Score Sheet Appendix by Wednesday, October 6th, 2021.
